CHIRUNDU MISSION 2016**

I was so excited to be part of the people that went on mission to Chirundu in December 2016. All I wanted was to be used by God to reach others with the wonderful message of my Lord Jesus. I arrived on mission like others in high spirits and ready for my Father's business.

On the first day in the field, I went out with my field partner and that day we visited several houses sharing the word of God. I helped people with chores so that we could have studies with them. This in itself was highly humbling for me as I could see God speaking to others through me. As the day progressed, my partner and I went to a certain young lady's house and had a study. In the course of the study, one drunk man only identified as Mr. Nchimunya approached us and requested to join the study. We allowed him. During the study, he showed great interest as he asked some questions. After the study, he asked for prayers saying he wanted to change his life and become a better person.

I noticed from the interaction that he was genuine and I was moved by his request. When I went back to the camp, I shared this prayer request with the prayer band and I decided to choose him as the person I would pray for during the whole mission. During the mission, we also had a health expo and Mr Nchimunya attended. As the event progressed, I saw him cry as he shared about his life and his wish to become a better man.

Fast forward, I'm happy to report that at end of the mission, Mr Nchimunya was among the people that got baptized. We left a new church which we started as IMPACT since there was no church in the mission's area. The church has since grown. I was privileged to be part of the missionaries that went back to Chirundu for a follow up visit after years. I found Mr Nchimunya. He is still strong in the faith and his wife was getting baptized that day. It was so amazing to see that God could use a person like me to reach out to someone and turn their life around just by sharing the gospel. I now realize God answered my prayer in ways I did not foresee, and I believe he still works to win many to the kingdom. I believe; if God can use me he can use you too.

NGABWE MISSION 2022

Ngabwe is situated in the outskirts of Kabwe in the Central Province of Zambia. This area experiences a number of challenges such as low levels of education, poor health infrastructure, inadequate supply of medicines, early marriages, teenage pregnancies and substance abuse. The livelihood of the people in this area revolves around small economic activities such as cattle ranching, fish farming and small businesses. The gaps in the provision of quality education, skills development and health services have led to increased poverty levels in the area.

IMPACT in partnership with Midlands East Zambia Conference Adventist Youth Ministries will embark on an outreach mission to Ngabwe from 18th to 31st December, 2022.
